"It Is Finished" A Tenebrae Service with Lenten Cantata

Presented by the Chancel Choir and Chamber Orchestra
Good Friday, April 19, 2019, 7:30 PM

You are invited into this place to survey the wondrous cross and to contemplate the dramatic and historic events of Holy Week. We will hear again the Holy Scripture and story of God's loving plan and purpose in the suffering of Christ to redeem us from sin and death.

We will pray that we may be transformed anew as we remember Christ's humiliation and that we may be taught obedience as we remember Christ's obedience until death. May we love one another as Christ showed love for all people.

"Tenebrae" comes from the Latin meaning "shadows" or "darkness," so it is a service of shadows. The Tenebrae service makes use of gradually diminishing light through the extinguishing of candles to symbolize the events of Holy Week from the triumphant Palm Sunday entry through Jesus' burial. The increasing darkness symbolizes the approaching darkness of Jesus' death and hopelessness in the world without God.
