Stewardship Campaign

In 2015, the church completed major building enhancements with a price tag of \$3.5 million. In 2012 and 2015, three-year "In tHIS House" campaigns were conducted to do this work and service the loan. Our debt now stands around \$2 million and we are doing a third campaign this fall, with the goal of securing commitments over the next 3 years of \$1.2 million. To raise this amount of money over 3 years will take dedication and commitment by all; it is a 50% increase over the commitments made with our last campaign. We will need significant sacrifice to reach this goal. Partnering with Ohio Guidestone



Ohio Guidestone a has history with the United Methodist Church in Ohio that goes back decades.
