Fourth Sunday -

On this fourth Sunday of Advent, we rejoice in the faithfulness of God. Even when we forget about Him or go our own way, He upholds His covenant of love with us. To make things right with us, He sent His Son as a baby who became a man who died on the Cross to bring us forgiveness of sins.

"This is what the Lord says, 'In the time of my favor I will answer you, and in the day of salvation I will help you; I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people, to say to the captives, 'Come out,' and to those in darkness, 'Be free!'" – Isaiah 49:8

Today, we re-light the candle of expectant hope, disruptive joy, and jealous love; and we light the candle of peace, remembering that we have peace with God through the covenant faithfulness we see in the sacrifice of Jesus Christ.
